Nobody is in attendance on behalf of the petitioner. The perusal of the record of the case file reveals that the learned Chief Court passed the impugned short order dated 04.05.2012 whereby the petition/Civil Revision No. 05/2009 was dismissed being meritless subject to detail judgment to follow, however, the then learned Judge (Mr. Justice Muzaffar Ali, J) has not delivered any detail judgment for a considerable time of one year. Whereafter he was elevated as Judge of this court.
